SA Army Foundation Group Life Scheme

It is with pleasure that Army Foundation wishes to inform members that SANLAM have agreed that SA Army Foundation monthly Group Life premiums of R 50,00 and R 80,00 will remain unchanged but the Life Cover benefit will **increase** as from **1 January 2012**.

With effect from 1 January 2012, **Reserve Force** members of the SA Army Foundation will no longer pay R 40,00 and R 60,00 for Group Life cover and membership, but will pay the same monthly premiums as permanent members with identical Life Cover benefits, (*R 50,00 single members, R 80,00 married members*).

The new Benefit Structure for all SA Army Foundation members (including Reserve Force) is as follows:

Single Member

Premium	Benefit
Membership & Group Scheme: R 50,00	New death and disability benefit: R 11 500,00 (Previous death / disability benefit: R 10 500,00

Married Member

Premium	Benefit
Membership & Group Scheme: R 80,00	New death and disability benefit: R 23 100,00 (Previous death / disability benefit: R 21 000,00

SA Army Foundation Wills and Testaments

From January 2012, members of the SA Army Foundation can get free advice on their wills and testaments from SANLAM Trust, There are three (3) options available:

- Consultants can draft wills free of charge for SA Army Foundation members if the gross assets value is more than R 500 000,00.

- If it is a complex will and the member's assets is more than R 500 000,00, SANLAM Trust will draft the will at a nominal fee of R 176,70.

SANLAM Trust will keep the wills in safe custody, free of charge, if SANLAM Trust is the executor.

- If the member's assets is less than R 500 000,00 SANLAM Trust will provide SANDF HR with a template of wills where a member of the family can be nominated as the executor to save future
